The Linnaean system for naming animals underlies all modern zoological taxonomy and nomenclature, and is the basis for all applied sciences that are involved with animals. This is reflected in *The International Code for Zoological Nomenclature*, which provides a guide to contemporary zoologists involved in naming species. The International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature develops the Code and resolves nomenclatural problems. Resolving these problems always involves access to original works, and the Commission applauds and welcomes the invaluable access to Linnaeus's works and specimens that will be made possible by Linnaeus Link.
